

Motion for 2023 AGM. Proposed by Jo Boerema-Barr, second by Keith Norris.

Motion to amend 14.4 to read:

14.4 Notice of Meetings: The Chief Executive will send out to all Members, at least 28 days prior to the date fixed for the Annual General Meeting, a notice giving details of the date, time and place of the Annual General Meeting. The accidental omission to give notice of a meeting or the non-receipt of notice of a meeting by any Member entitled to receive notice shall not invalidate the proceedings at that meeting.

Motion to add:

14.5 The Chief Executive will send to all members at least 14 days prior to the date fixed for the Annual General Meeting a formal notice of all business to be transacted.

Rationale:

Currently rule14.4 Notice of Meetings: The Chief Executive will send out to all Members, at least 14 days prior to the date fixed for the Annual General Meeting, a notice giving details of the date, time and place of the Annual General Meeting. However, rule 13.2 (Nominations for election) and 14.3 Proposals and items for discussion must be submitted at least 21 days before the meeting.

It is unrealistic to require nominations, proposals and motions to be received 7 days before members are officially notified of the meeting. These proposals correct that anomaly.
